Food so good, you'll become a repeat visitor!

We have become huge fans of this restaurant, in a very short time.

Our first visit was a Saturday evening. My wife and I had spent the day playing at the beach, and had worked up a good appetite. So we decided to try out this luxurious seeming restaurant right on the beach.

We were greeted with a warm welcome, and the host allowed us to pick our own table. The restaurant was populated with many guests and staff, plus there was live music. Everyone seemed to be having a great time. One thing I appreciated, was that the music wasn't too loud, so we could still have a decent conversation.

Our server, Linda, was a wonderful young lady who took very good care of us.

We ended up ordering an appetizer, the Big Pig, which is thick cut bacon with a mango apple cider dip. Very tasty, it was the perfect start. For my main course, I had the Seared Tuna Steak, which has a balsamic glaze and comes with roasted vegetables and sautéed potatoes (although I was able to substitute an extra side of veggies instead of the potato). This was one of the best tuna steaks I've ever had.

My wife ordered the Chicken Mushroom - a sous vide chicken breast in a creamy mushroom sauce, and she opted for the double vegetables side. (I didn't know what sous vide meant, so I had to look it up afterwards.) Since she couldn't finish, I got to eat a good portion of it, and it was delicious!

After eating, we enjoyed the ambiance and some good conversation over a nice bottle of wine, and then Linda talked us into some dessert: a Chocolate Mousse Cheese Cake. My wife loved it and forced me to try some. I'm not partial to sweets, but that was pretty darn fantastic!

The service was the best we've had in Grenada, and so was the food. We loved the experience so much, we made sure to let Linda and her manager know how pleased we were. And, of course, we vowed to come back.

Our next visit was just a few days later. This time just for lunch.

I ordered the Tuna Nicoise salad. Wow! It came on a bed of arugula & lettuce, with olives (in Grenada, yummy), tomatoes, hard boiled egg, and a red wine dressing. My wife ordered the Asian Chicken sandwich - a very tasty sandwich with sesame, cashew teriyaki glaze, cabbage, scallion, and ginger mayo. It was very good as a whole, but the ginger mayo was a real treat by itself. No

dessert on the second visit.

We watched as staff took pride in the appearance of the restaurant. From sweeping sand off the cement, to fluffing pillows on the beach veranda, and overall excellent service, it was clear that they care about a guest's experience

Service the second time was again, truly above average. This time, Lister was the young man to serve us, and he did very well.

Both times, the food looked and smelled so good, that I started eating before thinking to take pictures. But, I'm sure there are lots of those photos on the internet. I did get some pre-dinner photos of the view from our table.

There is a good variety to the short menu. And the prices are very reasonable, especially for the quality of the food.
